Regulations:

- 1. Degree Requirements/Credits Required for Graduation: A minimum of 36 credits, including 15 credits from compulsory courses and 21 from elective courses
 - —compulsory courses: 15 credits
 - -elective courses: 21 credits
 - International students require a minimum of 36 credits, including 18 credits from compulsory courses and 18 from elective courses

Students will need to complete a minimum of 36 credits to be eligible for graduation.

- 2. Credit Exemption: International students may select courses related to the theme of their thesis, so long as the number of credits for such courses totals no more than 6. In other words, students are allowed a maximum of 6 exempt credits (to be earned in courses related to the theme of their thesis offered outside the program/department/college/school) to count towards the total required elective credits for graduation, subject to the approval of an application made <u>in writing</u> to their academic advisor and to the Director of the Department.
- 3. Students who are accepted should refer to the Master's Degree Regulations for details. Matters not mentioned herein shall be governed by the English Department's regulations.
